EXPRESSION OF INTEREST



The primary function of the National Professional Standards Panel is to educate, encourage and assist members to uphold standards of professional conduct and to meet the ethical and professional obligations set out in the APA Code of Conduct. The Panel also manages specified categories of complaints according to approved procedures.

There is at least one vacancy for APA members on the National Professional Standards Panel for a two year term of office expiring 31 December 2018.

Eligibility criteria

- a financial member of the APA but not an APA Director or a current member of a Branch Professional Standards Panel
- demonstrated interest in matters relating to professional and ethical standards of practice, preferably within the health care industry
- available for meetings or teleconference meetings held approximately every two months.

- A **brief summary** of the applicant's professional background (maximum 300 words)
- A **brief statement** outlining why the applicant would be a suitable appointment to the National Professional Standards Panel (maximum 300 words)
